Applicants who have already participated in the above programme previously will not be considered for the course. After attending the course the participant has to submit a presentation and workshop report to NACWC.
- 4. It is further informed that, the 'Revised Guidelines for OPCW sponsored Events' issued and hosted on the NACWC website, must be followed while forwarding the nomination to this office.

I am pleased to extend to you an invitation to nominate a representative of your country to attend a regional Table Top Exercise on Chemical emergency Response (TTX 2019) which will be held in Nusa Dua, Indonesia from 29 October to 1 November 2019, this event is part of the capacity building program under Article X of the CWC and jointly organised by the Technical Secretariat of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons and the Government of Indonesia.

The main focus of this TTX will be on operational and procedural aspects of Response, consequence management and international assistance in the case of a major chemical incident, in the light of the relevant OPCW decisions and policies on response to incidents involving chemical warfare agents or other toxic chemicals and provision of assistance. Its objective is to support States Parties in the region to exercise operational frameworks, policy making, communication and information sharing, at national, regional and international levels, in order to ensure effective response and facilitate the provision of international assistance in case of chemical incidents.

Specific exercise objectives include:

- Exercise and assess national/regional and international procedures for response to an emergency situation
- Identify stakeholders and relevant decision-makers
- Exercise information flow in an emergency situation
- Exercise the OPCW- TS capabilities to respond to a request for assistance under Article X and its decision making process on provision of assistance;
- Focus on coordination of assistance between relevant international organisations and from other States Parties;
- Practice co-operation in consequence management during a major chemical incident.

Given the purpose of the TTX 2019 and its focus, all participants should be personnel involved in emergency management, development of an emergency-response system and/or members of the first response teams in their respective country.

The Secretariat expects to be able to sponsor the attendance at the workshop of a limited number of participants from States Parties. Each nomination should specify whether sponsorship is a condition of the nominee's participation. For sponsored participants, the Secretariat will cover the costs of travel, medical insurance, accommodation, and meals, and will provide a limited subsistence allowance to cover sundry expenses. Further details regarding accommodation, the course venue, and transport will be issued to all confirmed participants at a later date.

Participants are expected to arrive in Indonesia on Monday, 28 October and depart no later than Saturday 2 November 2019.

TTX 2019 will be conducted in English, and no interpretation services of any kind will be provided. Participants are therefore expected to have a good oral and written command of English.

Interested applicants are invited to register their nomination online through EVENTUS no later than 13 September 2019. The EVENTUS registration link is accessible via the OPCW website at: http://apps.opcw.org/eventus.

Please note that all the questions denoted with (*) need to be answered and endorsement letter from the National Authority (Annex II) had to be uploaded in order for nomination to be received and for the candidate to be considered for this event. Those who have been selected to participate will be contacted no later than two weeks after the submission deadline. Applicants who, for technical reasons, are unable to submit their application online via Eventus are requested to send the nomination form (Annex I) along with an endorsement letter from the National Authority to EmergAssistBr@opcw.org.
